

Introduction to the Gardens

① Entrance Hall



A specimen and a detailed replica of *Rafflesia arnoldii*, the world's biggest flower, are on display.

② Wet Tropics Garden



Visitors can learn about tropical and sub-tropical flora while enjoying various colorful tropical flowers and trees, Aroids and Palms.

③ Useful Tropical Plants Garden



Plants and fruits closely related to our lives, such as coffee, cacao, and tropical fruits such as bananas, papayas and mangoes are on display.

④ Air-conditioned Garden



Mild-climate orchids and Highland carnivorous plants are on display.

⑤ Dry Tropics Garden



A unique garden with many interesting plants native to arid regions, including *Welwitschia*, *Adansonia* and Cacti.

⑥ Night Garden



Nocturnal flowers including *Epiphyllum oxypetalum*, *Oenothera tetraaptera* and *Ipomea alba* are on display in this perpetually nighttime.

⑦ Alpine Garden



Alpine plants from Japan and overseas, as well as rare plants from Kyoto are on display in this garden, which is air-conditioned in Summer.

⑧ Orchids & Bromeliads Garden



Bromeliads and other plants native to South America are on display. Bromeliads are well known as exotic ornamental plants. Wild orchid are planted according to natural habitat, and Hybrids are displayed on the stage.
