# Measures for everyone to prevent the spread of infection!

At present, the major factors behind the spread of infections nationwide are the mutated variants of the virus that are said to be "highly contagious", "easily transmittable among young people", and whose symptoms are "fast to worsen" compared to conventional strains. In light of this, we request that each and every one of us take thorough measures to prevent the spread of infection.

#### 1 Take care not to become infected, and not to infect others!

- Please thoroughly implement basic infection prevention measures such as wearing a mask, washing your hands, securing physical distance, and avoiding areas with the three Cs.
- In order to reduce the chances of close contact between individuals, please also be careful about outdoor activities, such as attending various events.
- Most of infections take place via droplet infection where the virus enters mainly through the nose and mouth.
- Please correctly wear a mask when talking with others.

### 2 Thorough prevention of infection at eating and drinking opportunities

Please cooperate with Kyoto Manners when eating and drinking.

#### <Kyoto Manners>

- Dine at places with appropriate acrylic partitions and ventilation!
- · Wear a mask when talking!
- Disinfect your hands before eating and after leaving a restaurant!
- Do not speak in loud voices when at a restaurant!
- Limit the time to 2 hours, and the group size to 4 or less!
- Refrain from partying or home partying/drinking with individuals who aren't members of your immediate family that you live with
- Please refrain from drinking even outdoor.
- Please practice a new way of eating out, koshoku, eating alone, and mokushoku, eating in silence.

## 3 Infection prevention measures at the workplace

- Aim to "reduce the number of employees at the workplace by 70%" by implementing teleworking.
- · Reduce the chances of contact between people through measures such as staggered commuting

and online meetings.

- Enforce diligent ventilation by "visualizing" the CO2 concentration by installing a CO2 sensor.
- Properly take measures to prevent infections at the workplace, such as by installing acrylic partitions
- Please undertake thorough infection prevention measures for offices, rest spaces and locker rooms.
