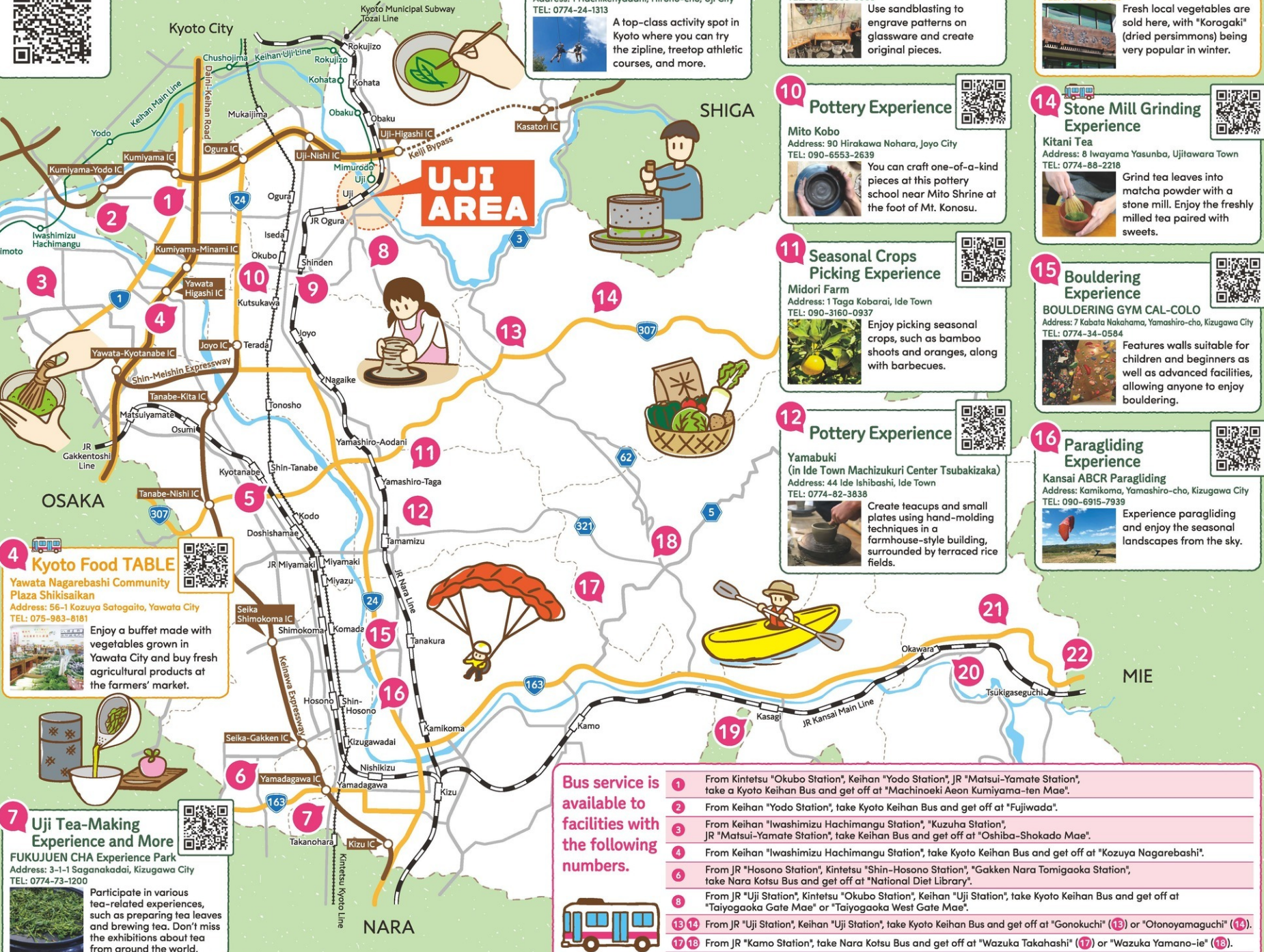

- From Keihan "Iwashimizu Hachimangu Station", "Kuzuha Station", JR "Matsui-Yamate Station", take Keihan Bus and get off at "Oshiba-Shokado Mae".
- From Keihan "Iwashimizu Hachimangu Station", take Kyoto Keihan Bus and get off at "Kozuya Nagarebashi".
- From JR "Hosono Station", Kintetsu "Shin-Hosono Station", "Gakken Nara Tomigaoka Station", take Nara Kotsu Bus and get off at "National Diet Library".
- From JR "Uji Station", Kintetsu "Okubo Station", Keihan "Uji Station", take Kyoto Keihan Bus and get off at "Taiyogaoka Gate Mae" or "Taiyogaoka West Gate Mae".
- From JR "Uji Station", Keihan "Uji Station", take Kyoto Keihan Bus and get off at "Gonokuchi" (13) or "Otonoyamaguchi" (14).
- From JR "Kamo Station", take Nara Kotsu Bus and get off at "Wazuka Takahashi" (17) or "Wazuka Yamano-ie" (18).
